PHIL COLLINS (Music & Lyrics) One of today's popular vocalists, songwriters performers, and has been hailed as one of the best drummers in the world. Collins has won seven GRAMMY® Awards and released solo albums with sales totaling more than 70 million copies. Among his accomplishments in film, he contributed songs to the GRAMMY® winning soundtrack of Disney's film, TARZAN®, including "You'll Be in My Heart, which was nominated for a GRAMMY® and won the Academy Award® and Golden Globe® for Best Song. Most recently, Collins wrote six songs and made his film-score composing debut (in collaboration with Mark Mancina) on Disney's Brother Bear and also composed the score for TARZAN® II. His 25 years with Genesis as drummer and singer resulted in another 130 million records sold, and factoring in his work with Brand X and a gallery of star groups and performers (including Led Zeppelin's Robert Plant, Eric Clapton, Brian Eno, Robert Fripp, John Cale, Quincy Jones, and Tony Bennett). Collins has left his mark on some 250 million records worldwide. His hit songs include "In the Air Tonight," "One More Night," "Subsidio," Take Me Home," Another Day in Paradise" and two other Oscar®-nominated songs: "Against All Odds and the Golden Globe®winning "Two Hearts." Phil's catalog has proved to be hugely popular with hip hop and R&B artists who continuously cover his songs. Among his other accomplishments, Collins fulfilled a lifetime ambition by touring with his own 20-piece big band, which made its debut in London's Royal Albert Hall in the company of conductor Quincy Jones and vocalist Tony Bennett. In 1981 Collins embarked on a solo career as well as continuing in his role as front man and drummer with Genesis. His solo albums include Face Value, Hello, Must Be Going, No Jacket Required, ... But Seriously; Serious Hits... Live, Both Sides, Dance Into the Light; Hits: Hot Night in Paris and Testify. Collins

most recently completed his successful Find Farewell Tour, playing to more than one million people in 25 countries.

DAVID HENRY HWANG (Book) Awarded the 1988 Tony ®, Drama Desk Outer Critics and John Gassner Awards for his Broadway debut. M. Butterfly, which was also a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize. For his play Golden Child, he received a 1998 Tony ® nomination and a 1997 Obie Award. His new book for the Rodgers & Hammerstein musical Flower Drum Song earned him his third Tony® nomination in 2003. He was also a book writer on Elton John and Tim Rice's Aida. Hwang's other plays include FOB (1981 Obie Award), The Dance and the Railroad, Family Devotions, The Sound of a Voice and Bondage. His opera libretti include three works for composer Philip Glass - 1000 Airplanes on the Roof, The Voyage and The Sound of a Voice - as well as The Silver River with music by Bright Sheng and Amoramor with Osvaldo Golijov Hwang penned the feature films M. Butterfly, Golden Gate and Possession (co-writer) and co-wrote the song "Solo" with composer/performer Prince. His new play, Fellow Face, will premiere next season. Hwang serves on the Dramatists Guild Council.

MIKE BEAMAN (Director) is on the Performance & Technical Theatre Faculty at Douglas Anderson School of the Arts, most recently directing Crucible. Mike has worked in NYC, New Hampshire, New Jersey, and Florida as an actor, director and educator. Favorite roles as an actor include Emcee in Cabaret (Limelight Theatre), Squidward in the Spongebob Musical (Players by the Sea) and Benedick in Much Ado About Nothing (Orlando Shakes). Mike sits on the State Board of the Florida Thespian Festival of the Educational Theatre Association, representing Northeast Florida as District Chair. As a theatre educator, Mike has been recognized by the National YoungArts Foundation (2020) and the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington DC (2015 Distinguished Director of a Play Award for Endgame at Flagler College).



for the Alabama State Concerto Competition, mock audition accompanist for the Fletcher Opera Institute, and accompanist for the North Carolina district Solo and Ensemble Festivals. Anthony has had the privilege of serving as Musical Director for the Broadway Musicals throughout the years and is grateful for the path his musical career has taken him. Fame, Annie, The Color Purple, Smokey Joe Café, Nunsense, Bye Bye Birdie, Joseph and the Amazing Techno-colored Dream Coat, Bingo, 13 the musical, Miracle on 34th Street, Title of Show to name a few. Recently, he was just awarded Outstanding Music Director at the 2024 Applause Awards.

EMMA CATE DAVIS (Choreographer) is thrilled to be choreographing her first show here at PBTS! Other choreography credits include Tuck Everlasting (Limelight Theatre); First Date (Limelight Theatre); Money from Cabaret (District 2 Student Choreography Critics Choice Winner 2024); & many other musical pieces! 
